

## SAFETY RULES

## 1. Masks must be on your face at all times when on playing fields.

- If you are caught taking off your mask or lifting it up at any point within the netted areas, whether this is before, during, or after a game, you will get SCREAMED at by our staff and other players.
- If you continue to lift or take off your mask after getting warned, you will be done for the day. You have proven to us that you can not be safe.
- We do not apologize and we do not discriminate.
- 2. Barrels bags and safeties must be on at all times when off of the playing fields.
- 3. Do not take apart our equipment and do not take ANY of it to the parking lot.
  - We fill your tanks while they are attached to your guns. We recommend you fill them up after each game so you will be ready for the next game.
  - Common issues with guns:
    - If your gun is not shooting, make sure your safety is off and your tank is filled with air.
    - If your gun makes a loud noise (like air releasing) pull the trigger again.
  - If you have any other issues with your equipment, see a staff member.
- 4. When you have been shot anywhere including your equipment, yell "I'm hit!" with your arms and gun in the air. This is the universal symbol that you are not in play.
- 5. Do not go on to any of the playing fields without a staff member.
  - We have a 5-10 minute wait time between games, so listen for a referee or horn for the beginning of a game.
  - The biggest reason people need to go out between games is the loss of a cell phone, keys, or wallet... do not take these on the field.
- 6. Do not pick up paintballs off the ground.
  - Paintballs that are on the ground STAY on the ground.
  - This includes throwing paint, breaking them on tables, and putting them inside of your hoppers. If you pick up paint off the ground and put it in your hopper, your entire hopper will be dumped.
- 7. You can only use paintballs bought at the field.
  - Please do not shoot any paint bought from other fields or stores. Our insurance does not allow this.
- 8. Do not shoot at wildlife, referees, airplanes, and motocross riders.
  - If you purposefully do this, you will be done playing for the day.
- 9. Do not blind fire.
  - If you can not see where your paintballs are going, you are blind firing. So stop.
- 10. No use of drugs or alcohol.
  - This includes in the parking lot. We know what trips to the car usually mean.
  - If you are caught doing this, your entire group will be done for the day
- 11. There are ZERO exceptions to all of these rules. PLAY SAFE AND HAVE FUN!!!
